Accident on Dangerous Stretch of Route 61 prompts \$400,000 PennDOT settlement

A man driving south on Route 61 was seriously injured when a northbound car crossed the center line and hit the man's vehicle head-on. The victim suffered disabling leg injuries from the accident, which occurred on a notoriously dangerous stretch of the highway in Berks County, Pennsylvania. The other driver had minimum insurance coverage, but the attorneys' claim against PennDOT for failure to erect a median barrier in this accident-prone area resulted in a recovery of over \$400,000.
